OMAHA -- Young performers with a yen to portray flowers, teacups, and other Lewis Carroll creations should pre-register now to audition for roles in Ballet Nebraska's upcoming *Alice in Wonderland*, artistic director Erika Overturff said.

Open to youths age 7 and up, the auditions require online pre-registration by **Wednesday, January 16,** at http://balletnebraska.org/participate/alice2013-auditions/. Pre-registered participants will audition on January 19 at Motion 41 Dance, at 2819 S 125th Avenue in Omaha. More than 80 youth roles will be available for casting, Overturff said.

"This is an exciting opportunity for children to be part of a professional stage production," Overturff said.
"Not only is it a chance to perform, it's a way for them to experience how theater works, and to get a close-up view of our professional dancers' dedication and artistry."

Guest choreographer Kennet Oberly is staging *Alice in Wonderland* for Ballet Nebraska, the region's only professional dance company.
